Registration Information

Enclosed is the registration information for the Battle of Pleasant Hill hosted by the 3rd. La. Infantry, Trans Mississippi Volunteer Infantry Battalion.

Amenities provided will include firewood, water and hay for both horses and bedding of troops. The first 20 pre-registered **FULL SCALE** cannons will receive 10lbs of powder.

NO SCALE ARTILLERY PIECES. There will be period entertainment Saturday night.

There is a registration fee of \$5.00 per person over the age of 12. All units and individuals must be registered and paid as soon as possible.

Friday morning will be school day. area kids will be bused in between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM. If you wish to participate just let us know.

The normal rules for safety will be followed at all times. No one will be allowed on the field under the influence of alcohol. Illegal substances will not be tolerated and will be reported to the proper authorities.

All weapons and ammunition will be inspected before each battle. Inspection will also include uniforms and equipment. **Only officers and cavalry troopers will be allowed to carry side arms. Please remove all modern wrist watches and eye wear.** You must be inspected to participate. At no time will paper cartridges or ramrods be placed in the musket when loading. **Cartridges with staples will not be allowed.** **Due to insurance concerns all combatants must be at least 16 years of age. Children without a specific duty and children as color bearers will not be allowed on the field.**

All combatants must be registered and a part of a unit on the field. To participate you must be a member of a unit or a unit commander vouches for you. that commander will be responsible for your proficiency in drill and that all safety measures are followed.

All battalions will stay together under their own commanders. Unattached companies will be assigned to a battalion. The chain of command will be followed throughout the event.

As requested by the landowner at Pleasant Hill:

Only fire pits may be dug. No trenching around tents is allowed.

Please fill in all fire pits before leaving on Sunday.

Please remove your trash to the dumpster near suttlers' row.

All cartridge paper and foil from cannons must be removed from the field.

As is always the case, Union troops will be out numbered. Please consider bringing both uniforms and galvanizing for at least one battle. Too many Confederates on the field can get a little congested.
